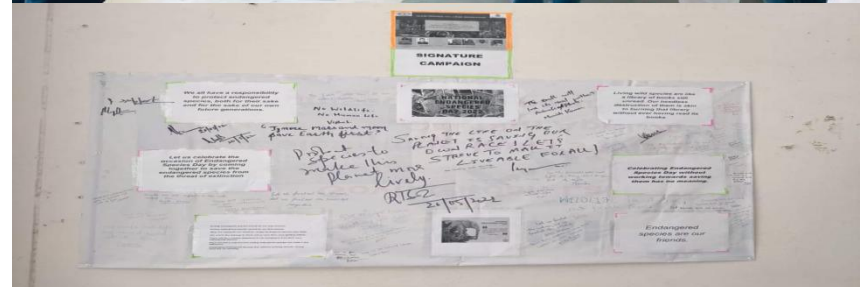
YUVA TOURISM CLUB OF GLDM DEGREE COLLEGE, HIRANAGAR VISITS JANDI (19-05-22).

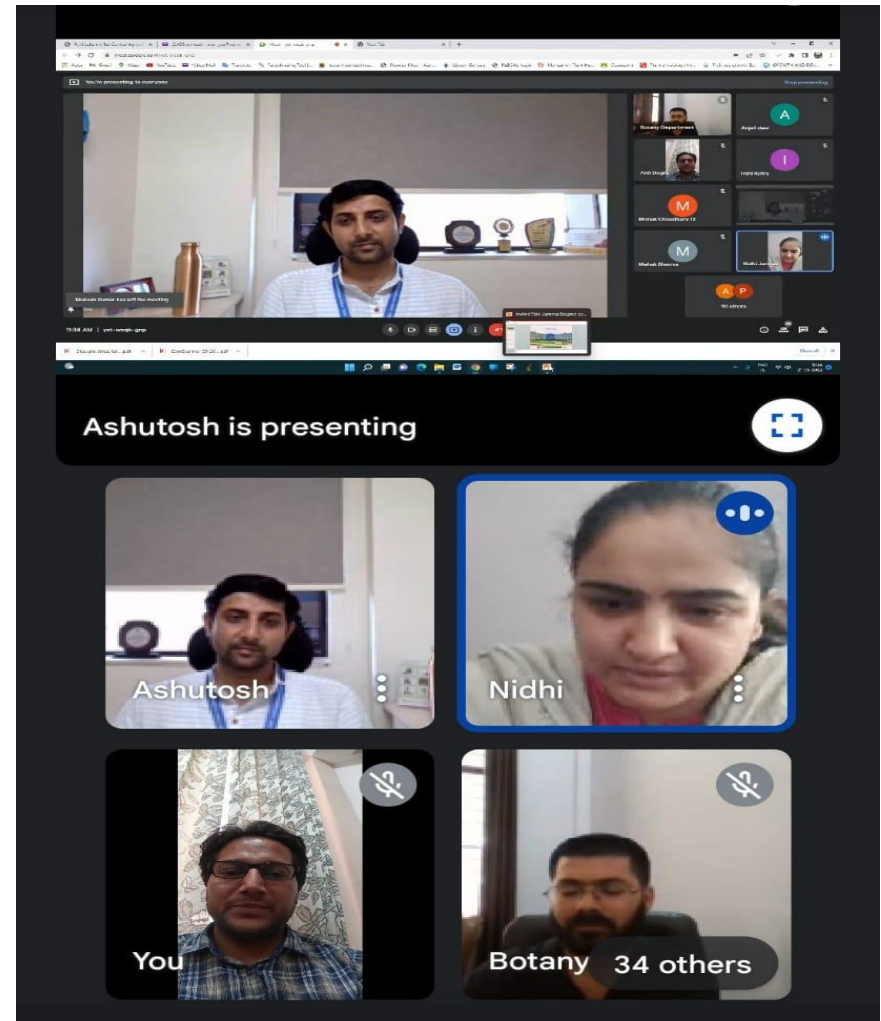
Awareness Program on Entrepreneurship Development (20-05-22)

Drought stress is a multidimensional stress and causes changes in the physiological, morphological, biochemical, and molecular traits in plants. In his lecture he deliberated on the fact that drought represents a severe environmental threat to plant productivity in agriculture

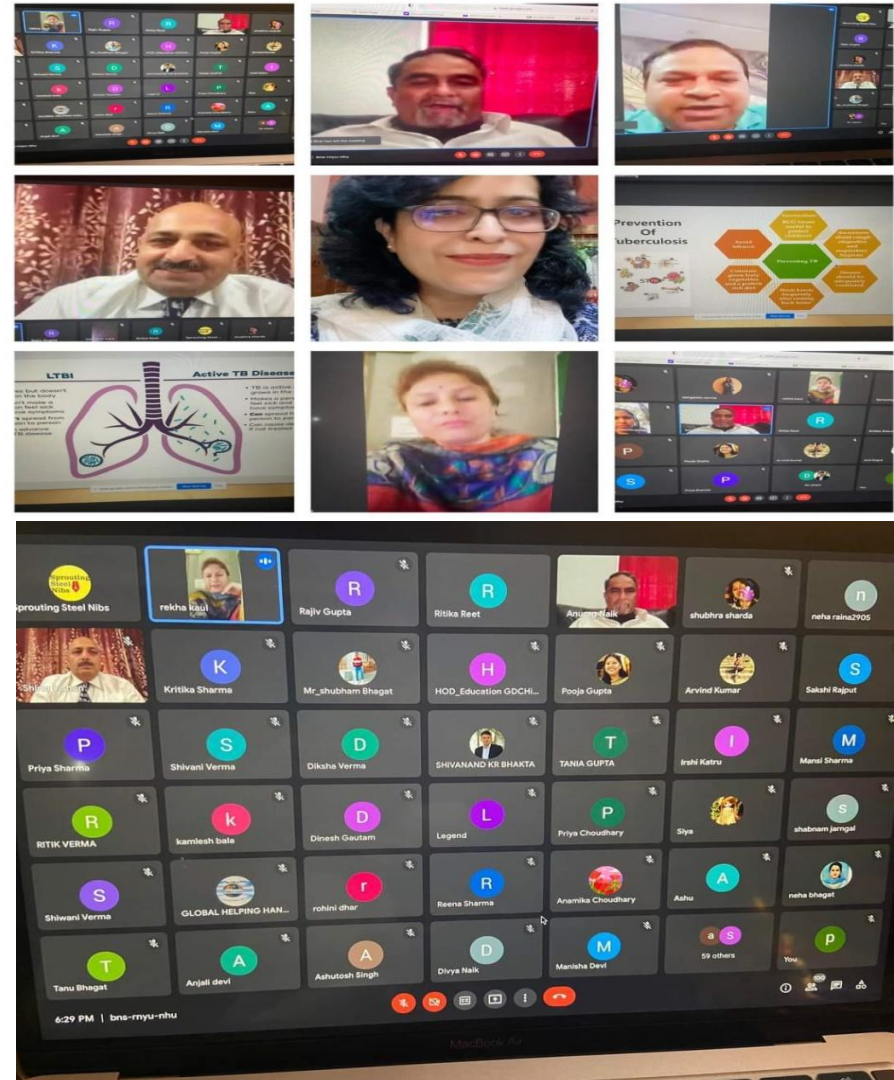
A Tribute to late Pandit Shiv Kumar Sharma(21-05-22).

GLDM, Govt. Degree College, Hiranagar Organizes a Mega-event on 'Fight Against Deadliest Diseases' – 22-05-2022

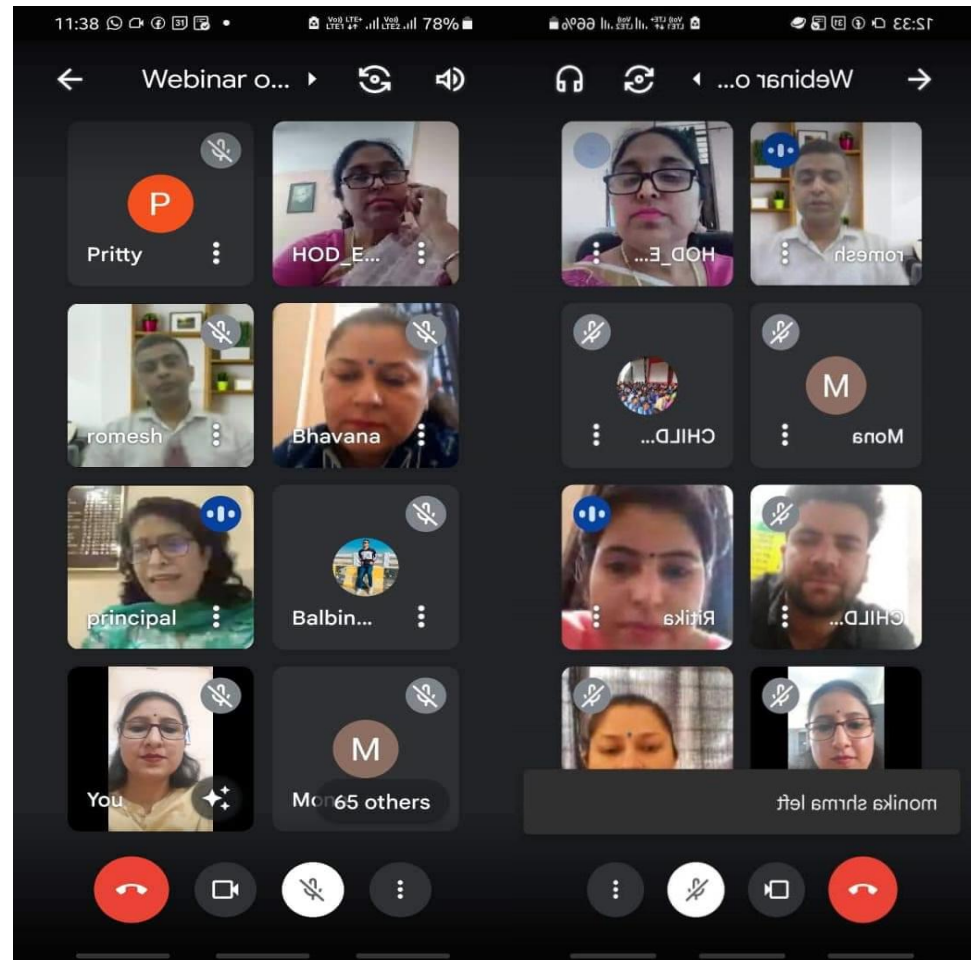

Webinar on “STRESS MANAGEMENT”

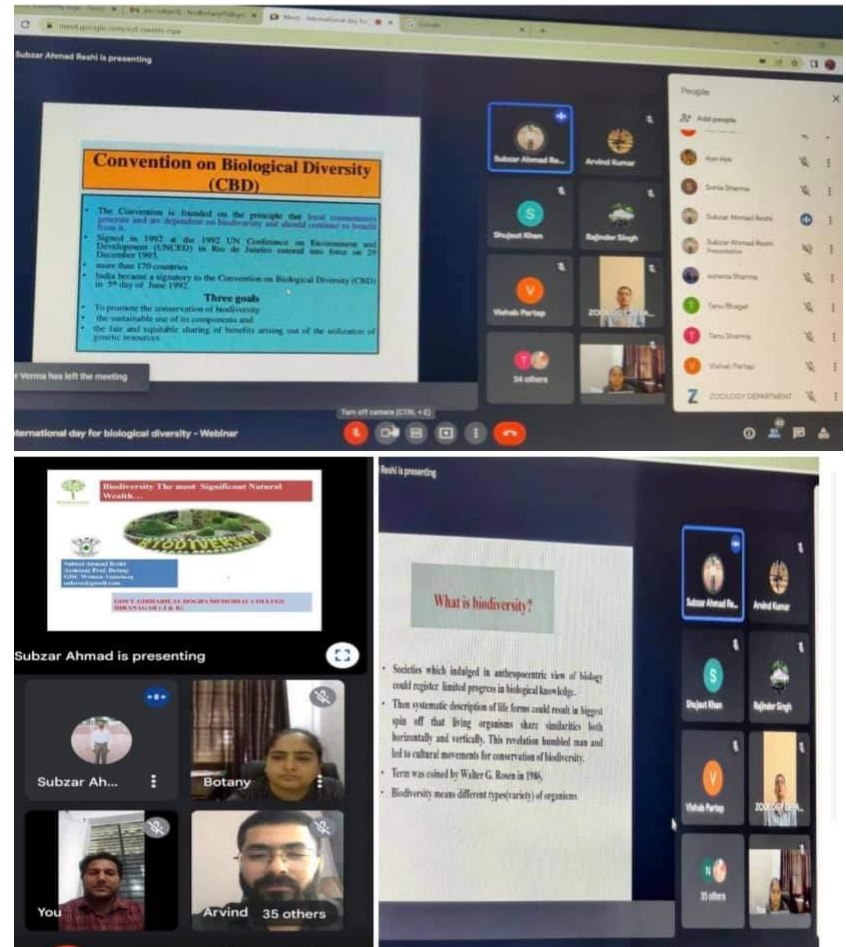

Photography Contest at GLDM, GDC, Hiranagar by the Eco-Club (23-05-22)

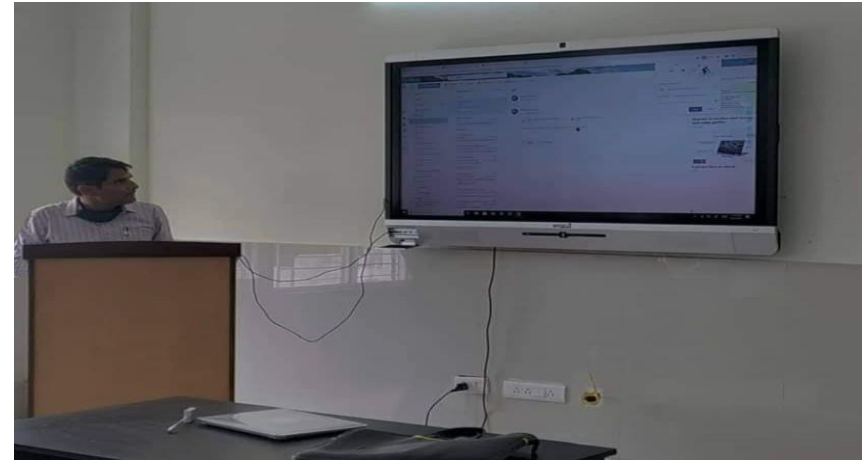

Yuva Tourism Club visited Jasmer Garh Fort (24-05-22)

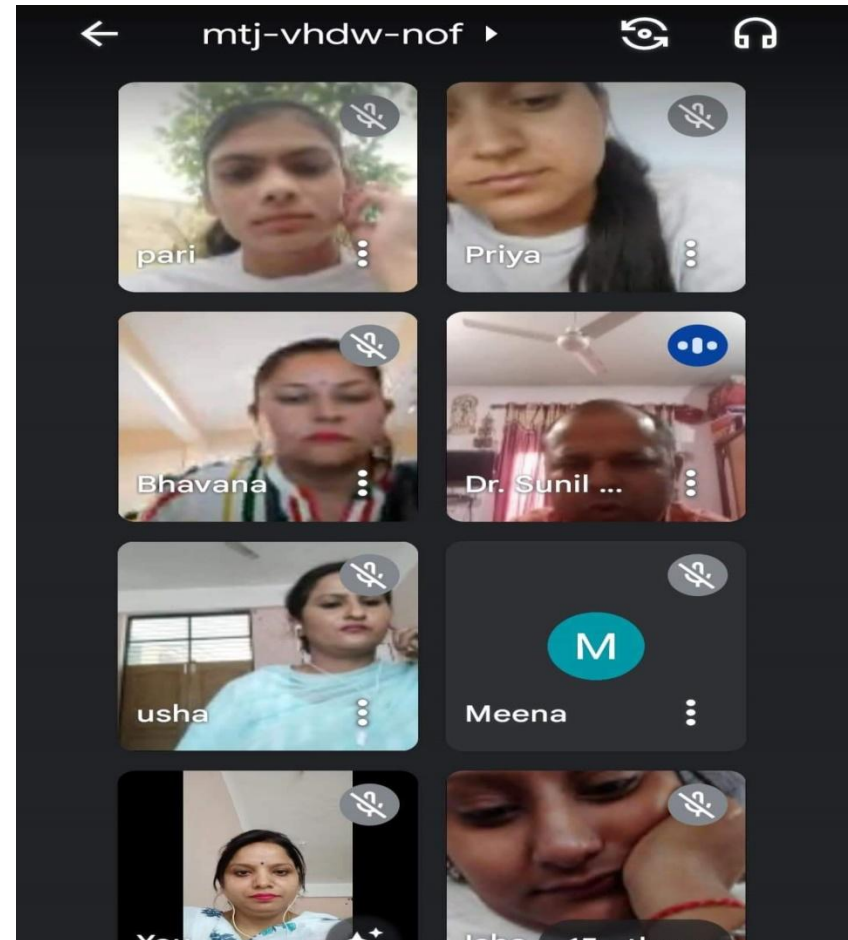

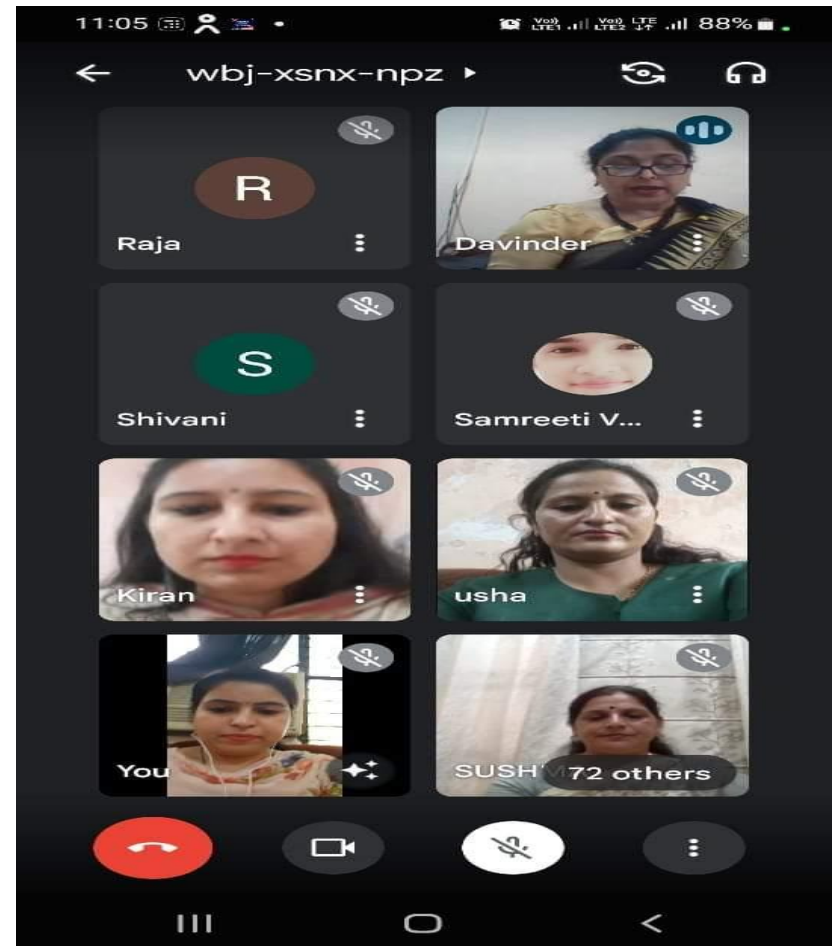

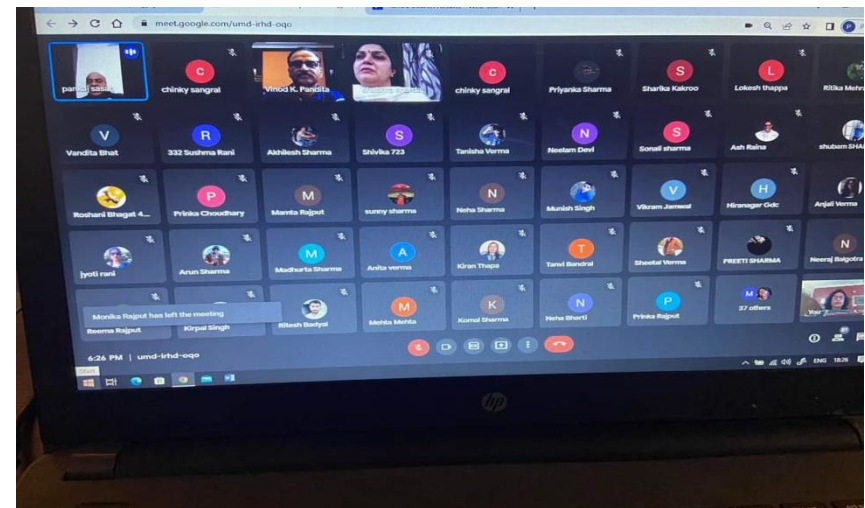
