## IN PURSUIT OF EXCELLENCE

### INTRODUCTION

In pursuance of its Action Plan for performance evaluation, assessment and accreditation and quality up-gradation of institutions of higher education, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore proposes that every accredited institution should establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as a post-accreditation quality sustenance measure. Since quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC will become a part of the institution's system and work towards realisation of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. The prime task of the IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institutions. For this, during the post-accreditation period, it will channelize all efforts and measures of the institution towards promoting its holistic academic excellence.

The guidelines provided in the following pages will guide and facilitate the institution in the creation and operation of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The work of the IQAC is the first step towards internalization and institutionalization of quality enhancement initiatives. Its success depends upon the sense of belongingness and participation it can inculcate in all the constituents of the institution. It will not be yet another hierarchical structure or a record-keeping exercise in the institution. It will be a facilitative and participative voluntary system/unit/organ of the institution. It has the potential to become a vehicle for ushering in quality enhancement by working out planned interventionist strategies to remove deficiencies and enhance quality like the "Quality Circles" in industries.

### IQAC OBJECTIVES

2. To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

10. Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC, to be submitted to NAAC.

# INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL: EVENTS AND PROGRAMMES

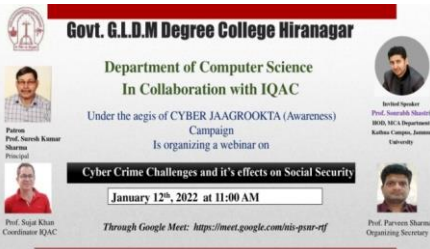
## 1. CELEBRATION OF HINDI DIWAS (10-01-2021).

An inter- college eassy and poetry writing competition on international mother language day is organised by Department of Dogri under the aegis of IQAC.

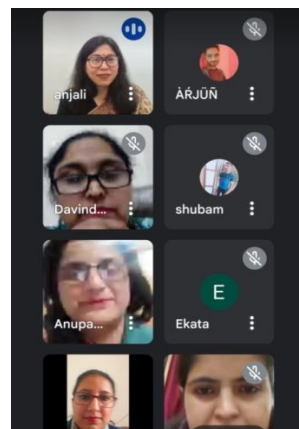
#### Inter-college Essay and Poetry writing competition held at Govt. GLDM Degree College Hiranagar.

### 11. AN ONLINE INTRA-COLLEGE QUIZ COMPETITION (26-02-2022 to 28-02-2022).

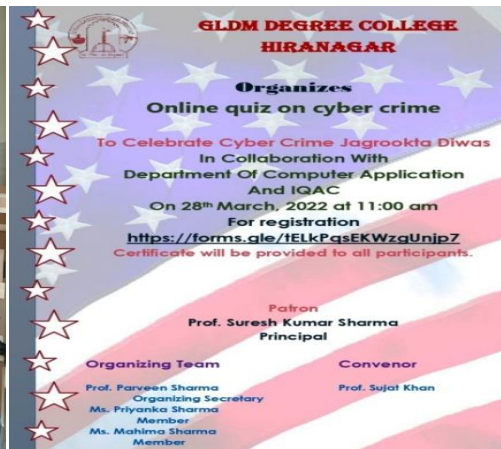
**Organised by:** Department of Education under the aegis of IQAC.

The Department of Botany observed World Tuberculosis Day, 2022. On this day, a Webinar was organized on this year's theme '**Invest to End TB Save Lives**' to convey the urgent need to invest resources to ramp up the fight against TB and achieve the commitments to end TB made by global leaders. The Guest Speaker Mr. Owais Rashid Hakiem, (Ph.D) University Of California, Irvine, mentioned about the causative organism of Tuberculosis and how disease is being transmitted from one organism to another. He briefly talked about the History, Global Prevalence of TB and estimated TB incidences in Top Ten Countries and highlighted the difference between Latent TB and Active TB and how weakening of immune system leads to development of active TB from latent TB. He also talked about the various detection methods and current controls against TB.



20. QUIZ COMPETITION FOR SEMESTER 1 (28-03-2022).

- Plasmodium ovale
- Plasmodium knowlesi



The Department of Botany and Zoology observed World Malaria Day, 2022. On this day, a Webinar was organized on this year's theme "**Harness innovation to reduce the malaria disease burden and save lives**" to convey the urgent need to invest resources to ramp up the fight against Malaria and achieve the commitments to end Malaria made by global leaders. 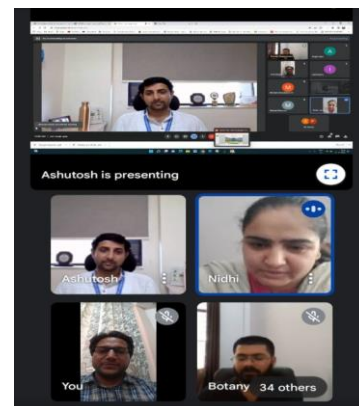

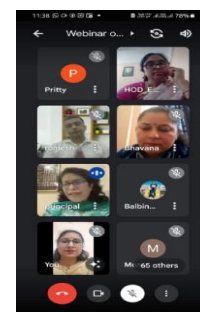

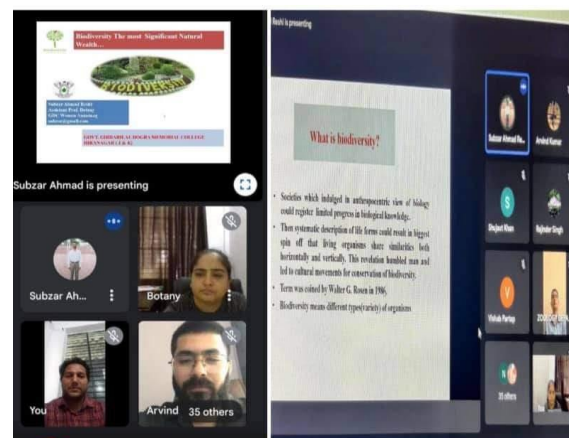
### 37. WEBINAR ON “STRESS MANAGEMENT” (23-05-22)

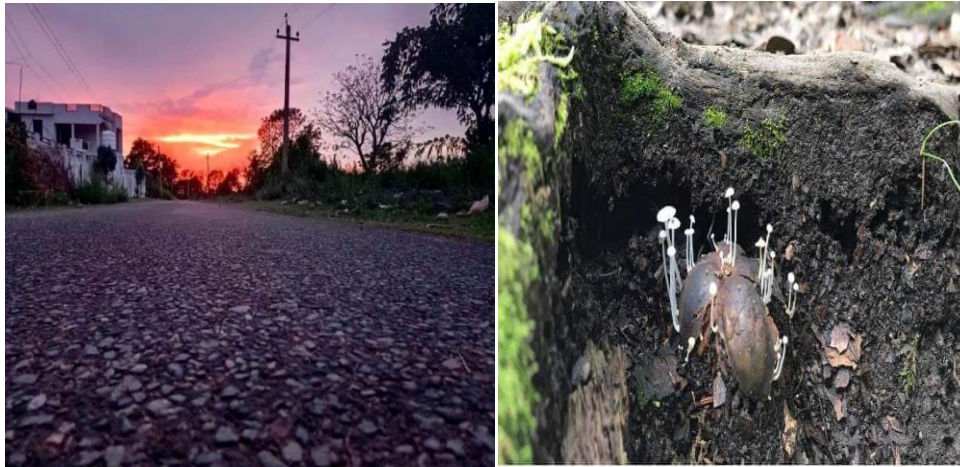


### 38. WEBINAR ON INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY (23-05-22).

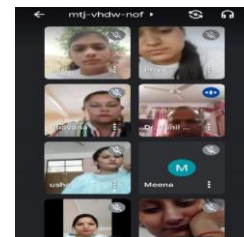
#### 42. YUVA TOURISM CLUB VISITED JASMER GARH FORT (24-05-22)

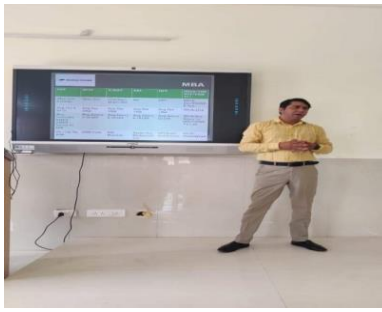

### 53. SKIP THE STRAW DAY (28-05-22)

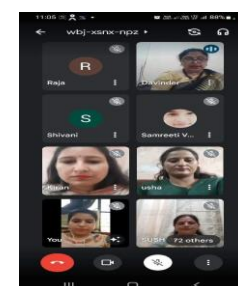
#### 10 DAYS ZERO WASTE CAMPAIGN, GLDM DEGREE COLLEGE HIRANAGAR. DAY 3:

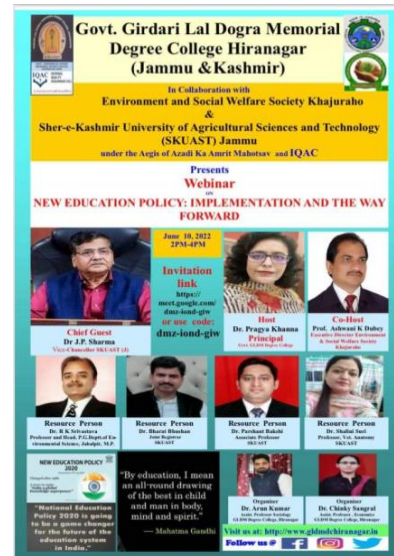
**67. QUIZ COMPETITION ORGANISED BY DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS**
