Resource persons Dr. Harish Chander Dutt(Assistant Professor) and Mr. Notan Kumar Katch (Curator, Herbarium and Museum Complex) from Department of Botany, University of Jammu enlightened the students about the recent classification system of plants, herbarium Techniques along with the medicinal and ethno- botanical uses of plants growing in the Botanical garden.

#### **Environmental Trip**

An Environmental trip to Surinsar was organised by Department of Environmetal Sciences on 28-03-2018. Approximately 550 students of B.A/B.Sc Sem-II and B.A/B.Sc Sem-IV (NON-CBCS) joined the trip.
